

# Indonesian Visa Procedure

## A. Free Visit Visa

Referring to Presidential Regulation Number 21 Year 2016 regarding Free Visit Visa, citizens from the following 169 countries are eligible for Free Visit Visa.

Free visit visa shall be valid for 30 (thirty) days, and it can not be extended or converted into another immigration permit. The general requirements for free visit visa are: (i) The applicant's passport must be valid for at least 6 (six) months from the date of entry, (ii) Round-trip airplane ticket.

This visa can be obtained when you arrive at certain airports as seen in the table below.

## **B. Visa on Arrival**

The Indonesian Government extends Visa on Arrival (VoA) to nationals of 61 countries which can be obtained at designated entry airports and sea ports. Visa-on-Arrival are valid for 30 days and are extendable with another 30 days to be applied at Immigration offices in Indonesia. Visas cost US\$35

### E. Calling Visa

Calling visa is approval by Director General for Immigration for visa application by citizens of certain countries as defined by a Decree of Minister Justice and Human Right. The current list of those countries are: ***Afghanistan, Guinea, Israel, North Korea, Cameroon, Liberia, Niger, Nigeria, and Somalia.***

Citizens from Calling Visa countries who are visiting Indonesia to participate in an International Conference can apply visa at the Indonesian Embassy, Consulate General, or Consulate in or accredited to that country, with the following requirements:

1. Passport valid for at least 18 months
2. Conference invitation letter
3. Return or onward tickets
4. Applicant's information including: general, personal data, passport, sponsor in Indonesia, and miscellaneous (a form will be provided upon request)

5. A Calling Visa country citizen who resides outside his/her home country and works as a lecturer; college student; expert; investor; or manager-level workers, may apply to the Representative of the Republic of Indonesia in Bangkok or the Representative of the Republic of Indonesia in Singapore.
6. Please consult the Embassy, Consulate General, or Consulate as early as possible to allow the necessary process.
